

# tsh quick reference sheet (revised 2009-05-17)

## launching tsh

1. ☐ open tsh folder
2. ☐ (Windows) dos-tsh3.bat
- ☐ (Mac) osx-tsh.command
- ☐ (Linux) ./tsh.pl

## standard workflow ☐

At the end of each round:

1. ☐ Enter scores.
2. ☐ Show, print, post standings.
3. ☐ Show, print, check scores.
4. ☐ Show, print, post pairings.

At the end of the event:

1. ☐ Show, print, announce prizes.
2. ☐ Submit data for ratings.

## browsing reports

Print reports from your web browser.

To browse the index of all reports:

```
tsh> b
```

To browse the last report created:

```
tsh> bl
```

## show standings/ratings

Current standings in Division B:

```
tsh> rat b
```

Standings for Rounds 7-9 in Division C:

```
tsh> rrat 7-9 C
```

## entering scores

To begin data entry mode in Round 12 for Division B:

```
tsh> a 12 b
```

Enter player numbers (or partial names) and scores (enter just one pair for a bye):

```
[B12]:pn1 ps1 pn2 ps2 (8 scores left): 3 400 Rich,Nig 300
```

Switch to entering scores for Division C:

```
[B12]:pn1 ps1 pn2 ps2 (6 scores left): c
```

List which games are still missing:

```
[C12]:pn1 ps1 pn2 ps2 (6 scores left): m
```

## checking scores

To check scores for Round 7 Division A:

```
tsh> crs 7 a
```

## showing pairings

Pairings are computed if needed when you ask to see them. E.g., Round 9 Division C:

```
tsh> sp 9 c
```

## correcting mistaken scores

To correct Division D player 22 in Round 3:

```
tsh> es D 22 3
```

D22's current scorecard will be displayed.

Now enter the correct pair of scores:

```
Chew, J (D22) R3 [300 400 first vs.  
Chew, L (D23)] (? for help) 400 300
```

The scorecard will be reshown. Press enter again to return to the main prompt.

## showing prizewinners

Provisional results shown if data is missing:

```
tsh> prz
```
